
How to turn your hearing aids on and off, and change the battery

Turning On

With a battery inserted, close the battery door completely to switch your hearing aids on.

Turning Off

Open the battery door until a click is felt to turn your hearing aids off.



Changing batteries

When the battery power is low

- Your hearing aids will beep when the battery is starting to run out.
- This warning beep will repeat every 15 minutes until the battery has completely run out.

To change the battery

- Remove the sticky label from the new battery.
- Open the battery door.
- Remove the used battery by pulling it upwards.
- Insert the new battery in its place. Make sure that the flat side (marked+) is facing upwards.

TOP TIP:

To save the battery, make sure you turn your hearing device off when you are not using it.
